

IMPORTANT NOTICE

TRASH & RECYCLING PILOT PROGRAM

City of Waller will be testing a **Pilot Program** for four (4) months for **HEAVY TRASH and RECYCLING**. We hope this will help our citizens with the removal of heavy debris, limbs, and recyclable items.

Republic Services will continue to run the entire city limits on each **1st Monday of the month**. **Citizens will no longer have to call into Republic Services for heavy bulk pick up ahead of time**. Customers may put out 4 items per month at the curb.

For the citizens wanting to use the curbside heavy pick up the City is still requesting that the items not be set at the curbside until the Friday before the 1st Monday of each month. Citizens not wanting to put heavy items at the curb may bring their items to the **Sewer Plant** located at **102 Walnut** on the Saturday prior to the 1st Monday of each month. The Sewer Plant will be open on that **Saturday from 8:00 am to 12:00 Noon**. Recyclable items may be brought to the Sewer Plant on this Saturday also.

SCHEDULE FOR PILOT PROGRAM:

Saturday, February 4, Sewer Plant 8:00 am to 12 Noon

Monday, February 6, Curbside Bulk Pick up

Saturday, March 3, Sewer Plant 8:00 am to 12 Noon

Monday, March 5, Curbside Bulk Pick up 8:00 am to 12 Noon

Saturday, March 31, Sewer Plant 8:00 am to 12 Noon

Monday, April 2, Curbside Bulk Pick up

Saturday, May 5, Sewer Plant 8:00 am to 12 Noon

Monday, May 7, Curbside Bulk Pick up

Limbs may be put at the curbside but will still need to be broken into 4 foot lengths, bundled and tied into 50 pounds or less. Limbs brought to the Sewer Plant will also need to be in 4 foot lengths, but do not need to be tied. Customer will be responsible for putting limbs and debris into the roll-offs. There will be a charge for tires brought to the sewer plant. Tires are not to be put at the curbside.

Customers using the Sewer Plant on the designated Saturday will need to bring a Utility statement and photo ID.

Recyclable Materials:

Aluminum cans, trays and foil, steel cans and tin, newspapers, cardboard, brown paper bags, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, cereal boxes, glass bottles and jugs, plastic bottles, and jugs.

Items need to be emptied and rinsed clean. Stream line recycling, no need to separate items. For items with Freon in them, **you MUST have a certification ON THE ITEM** that the Freon has been removed. It must be put out at the curb for pick up by Republic Services for the Monday Curbside Pick-up. If you have any questions please call **City Hall 936-372-3880 Monday –Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm**.
