1. The PS&E for this project will use the TxDOT Standard Specifications Manual (November 2014 edition)
2. On page 6 of the RFQ, please omit and disregard the 8th bullet under Item 3 (Success in gaining environmental approvals)
3. What is the SOQ page limit? There is no page limit to the overall SOQ, however, there are page limits to experience of assigned staff and team members to the project as well as page limits of sample projects similar to the project.
4. "A demonstration of the firms understanding of the project through an outline of their suggested approach to the project." Page limit? There is no page limit associated with this item in the RFQ.
5. Will the existing bridge with the pedestrian walkway remain in place? Yes
6. Any city initiated ACP overlay expected within the project limits? No
7. Any ACP associated with the project? This will be determined by the engineer of record for the project.
8. Where will inlets be located? This will be determined by the engineer of record for the project.
9. Will ADA ramps be required at intersecting streets? ADA/TDLR design standards will be used.
10. Will the drainage study only address addition of impervious cover (the proposed sidewalks)? Yes, unless deemed otherwise by the engineer of record for the project.
11. Estimated construction cost of the project? The TxDOT grant application construction estimate was approximately \$1.17 million
12. Will there be a requirement for public engagement on this project? There is no formal public engagement requirement for this project. Any minimal public engagement is listed in the 'Scope of Work' in the RFQ.
13. On page 7 of the RFQ, documentation is requested as to how the required 15% DBE goal will be met. Are there specific forms that must be filled out and included in the RFQ response? There is no specific form to be filled out. Please state the DBE, the tasks that the DBE will complete, and provide their TxDOT Unified Certification Program information. Percentages will be certified during the contract negotiation period.
14. Should the RFQ response identify the DBE firms to be used on the design team by their DBE credentials or can RFQ make a good faith effort statement regarding the achievement and compliance with the 15% DBE goal? If the prime contractor is using DBE, the prime should state the DBE, the tasks the DBE will complete and provide their TUCP certification information. A good faith effort should only be used when the Prime contractor cannot obtain the 15% DBE goal and provide a detailed account of their outreach efforts.
15. If a prime contractor is a DBE, does that meet the 15% DBE goal? Yes, provide your TUCP DBE information in the RFQ response.
